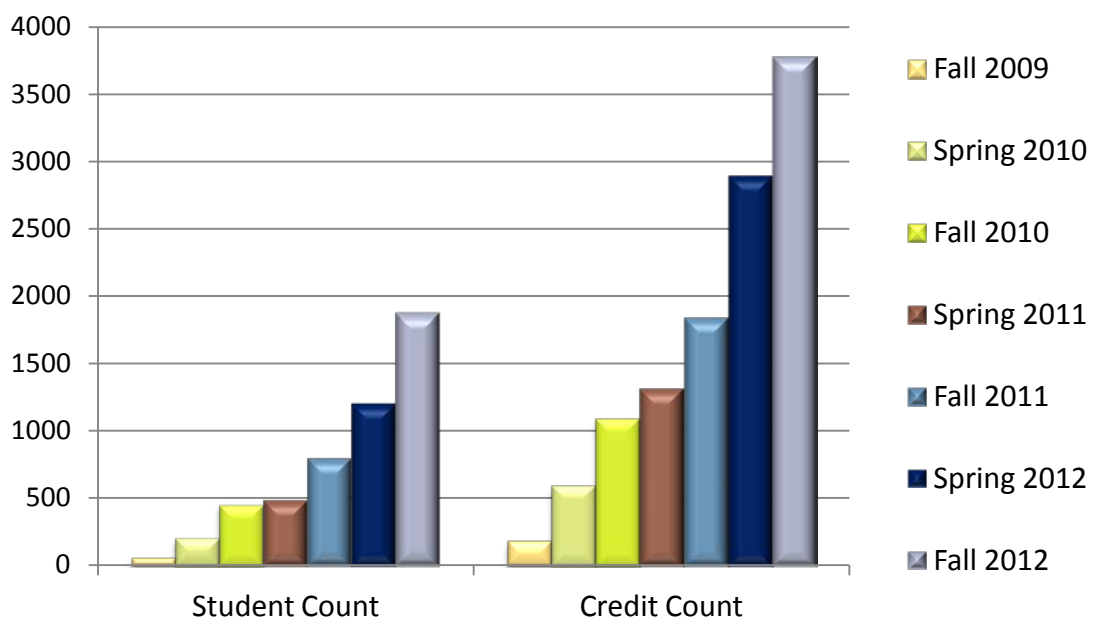

COMMUNICATIONS REPORT

The Idaho Education Network continues to offer solutions by providing access, collaboration and opportunity for students and communities across the state. **Access** for students to take hard to find and dual credit courses; **collaborations** for school boards, administrators and teachers to explore innovative practices in curriculum and technology, and **opportunities** for communities to build on their educational programs for students, parents or community members. The quality broadband network supports all districts and their individual needs while the video conferencing capabilities are limited only by imagination.

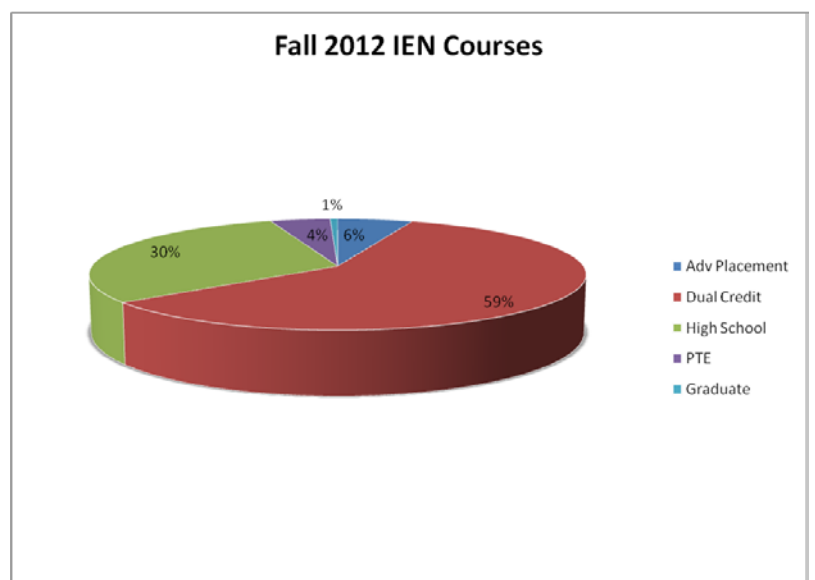
➤ Access

- Content – The numbers speak for themselves this fall term – 1850 students participated 178 classes of which over 65% were dual credit or advanced placement, awarding a total of 3776.5 credits and achieving a stunning 94% student retention rate.



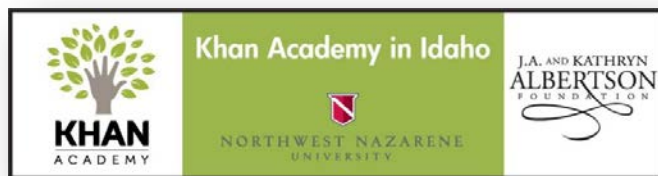
The majority of the courses offered over the IEN are dual credit – of the 3776.5 total credits awarded 2830 of the credits were dual credits which equates to just over 88 years of college at 32 credits per year.

The average savings per credit is 153.00 with a total savings for fall term 2012 of \$432,990.00



➤ Collaborations

- GEAR UP Lift Up America: Ambassadors of Compassion Kickoff Event – On January 5th, 600 parents and students who participated in the GEAR UP Idaho program filled the Simplot Ballroom for a presentation from Eric and Jodi Hannah from Lift Up America (<http://aoclife.org/>). The presentation was also available to a group of 50 additional students and parents at the College of Southern Idaho via video teleconference. The school districts that were involved with the event included Homedale, Weiser, Vallivue, Minidoka, and American Falls.



- In November, the IEN partnered with the J.A. and Kathryn Albertson Foundation, Northwest Nazarene University, and Integrity AV to offer virtual attendance via video teleconference to a live Khan Academy seminar. Wallace High School and Forrest

M. Bird Charter School in Sandpoint joined educators from around the state to participate in workshops hosted at the NNU Boise Campus on self-paced, individualized student learning opportunities with the Khan Academy.



- Idaho students at Cambridge Jr/Sr High School also participated in the Presidential Primary Sources Project, a collaborative program sponsored by the U.S. Presidential Libraries and Museums, National Parks, the Internet2 K20 Initiative, and other primary source stakeholders. The IEN participated as the statewide coordinator to connect local schools to national content providers. This yearlong project engages students using primary source documents for research and included a series of six interactive presentations from content providers during fall/winter 2012. Schools had the options of participating in individual content provider sessions or watching the recorded sessions afterwards. Cambridge Jr/Sr High School students participated in all interactive presentations and are currently working on their final project for the May 2013 project finale.

- The IEN recently partnered with the State Department of Education to participate in Digital Learning Day on February 6, 2013. This nationwide event celebrates teachers and “shines a spotlight on successful instructional practice and effective use of technology in classrooms across the country.” The IEN Talk Awards were revived to recognize our own education professionals going above and beyond to provide access in college preparation, recognizing new educators using the IEN, those teachers with longevity using the IEN, ones with innovative practices, and honoring one exceptional professional exemplifying IEN use above and beyond standards.



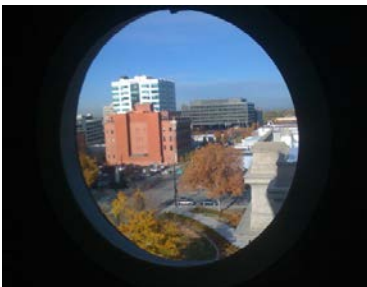
- Idaho Distance Education Academy (IDEA) – IDEA is using the Idaho Education Network to serve distance education students, and even parents, as a tool to connect with places and people around the globe. They have already done over 30 virtual sessions this fall and plan to do many more throughout the winter and spring. IDEA Boise students were kind enough to be the pilot location for the Idaho Capitol Tour session and were a great interactive audience. IDEA is also a recipient of the 2013 IEN Talk Award for Innovation recognizing their use of virtual sessions to supplement curriculum.

“These opportunities over the IEN have allowed students to experience places, professions, and content that they simply would not be able to access in any other way” – Jason Bransford, IDEA Executive Director.

- Idaho Digital Learning Academy (IDLA) – The IDLA is on track to serve over 20,000 students this year and relies greatly on the IEN bandwidth to deliver their online courses. IEN relies greatly on their content; in the fall they offered dual credit Calculus 1 and 2 from their VTC classroom. This term they are also offering a hybrid speech course and next fall we anticipate dual credit English 101 and 102 via their VTC room. The partnership increases access to dual credit courses from highly qualified Idaho teachers while accommodating multiple schedules.

➤ Opportunities

- Innovation Awards – The IEN is planning to roll out another Innovation Awards program in February and invite school districts who have demonstrated a willingness to use technology to increase access, opportunities, and collaborations for all learners to participate in the program.
- 10th Annual Megaconference Jr. – This free, international program scheduled May 2, 2013 is designed to help students around the world communicate, collaborate and contribute to each other's learning in real time. The Megaconference is day-long video conference that takes place over the IEN video unit located in high schools. The conference is designed to be "student-driven" and students are encouraged to plan and present their own material with support from teachers, coaches or other experts.
- Step Ahead Idaho, the College Access Challenge, and the IEN are offering free college preparation workshops for students in the 8th through 12th grades. Step Ahead Idaho has created a menu of options for schools who would like to schedule sessions for College and Career nights, Financial Aid information. Each session also includes Go On flash drives with college prep materials for each participant.



Recognize this view?

- Idaho State Capitol IEN Tours – The Capitol tour program via the IEN is up and running. Working with Michelle O’Brien in the Legislative Services Office and Jeff Tucker from Idaho Public Television, students around the state can learn about our state Capitol Building. The content is aligned to Idaho history courses and includes teacher packets to educate students on one of the most important places in our state. Schools who have already participated include IDEA Boise, Bonneville, and Kamiah.

➤ Website Social Media Outreach

- IEN in a Minute Analytics – IEN began using publishing platform MailChimp to send email updates and IEN in a Minute newsletters. This online tool contains real-time analytics to identify the impact of information contained within IEN communications.
- Website Analytics and Updates – Last summer, IEN began using Google Analytics to track IEN website performance and visitor traffic patterns. Staff discovered over 52% of visitors were not diving down into the site content beyond the home page and subsequently planned a web site update. Updates include a robust home page with quick links and an interactive event scheduling form.
- Social Media Analytics – IEN continues to have an active Twitter presence. Currently at 164 followers, IEN tweets relevant education news, live tweets during IEN activities and encourages distance learning opportunities. The live Twitter feed links into the Facebook page and will be featured on the updated website.
