## **Later Start Time School Parent Survey**

The Blackfoot School District Board of Trustees is evaluating options for implementing a later morning start time for students. Research clearly shows that such a change would benefit teens, whose sleep cycles shift around the time they enter 7<sup>th</sup> grade.
