**RESOLUTION CALLING FOR
SCHOOL PLANT FACILITIES RESERVE FUND LEVY ELECTION**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of School District No. 414, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho (the "District"), has heretofore, by resolution duly adopted, created and established a School Plant Facilities Reserve Fund;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 33-804 and 33-901, Idaho Code, as amended, the Board has determined there is a need for a School Plant Facilities Reserve Fund Levy in the amount of up to Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2026, and continuing each year in the amount of up to Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for ten (10) years, for the purposes permitted by law for school plant facilities levies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the District as follows:

- Section 1. That a school plant facilities reserve fund levy election (the "Plant Facilities Levy Election") be and the same is hereby called to be held in the District on Tuesday, May 19, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the District the question set out in the form of the ballot appearing in Section 5 hereof.
- Section 2. That the Clerk of Twin Falls County, Idaho (the "County Clerk") shall administer and coordinate the election pursuant to and in accordance with Title 34, Idaho Code, including scheduling the polling times; preparing and printing the ballots; and preparing and publishing notice of the Plant Facilities Levy Election and the sample ballot.
- Section 3. That in compliance with Section 34-1406, Idaho Code, the Clerk of the District shall notify the County Clerk that the District has called the Plant Facilities Levy Election by delivering to the County Clerk a copy of this Resolution, including the form of the ballot for the Plant Facilities Levy Election set forth in Section 5 hereof and the form of the notice of the Plant Facilities Levy Election set forth in Section 6.
- Section 4. That said election shall be conducted as other school elections by the County Clerk in accordance with Title 34, Idaho Code.

Section 5. That the District hereby approves the following form of ballot and form of notice for purposes of the Plant Facilities Levy Election for the Projects:

QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 414, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho (the "District") be authorized and empowered, upon the affirmative vote of fifty-five percent (55%) of the electors of the District voting in the election, to levy a School Plant Facilities Reserve Fund Levy in the amount of up to Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2026, and continuing each year in the amount of up to Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for ten (10) years through fiscal year ending June 30, 2036, for the purposes permitted by law for school plant facilities levies?

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$40 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy replaces an existing levy that expires on June 30, 2026, and that currently costs \$24 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value. Therefore, if the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is expected to increase by \$16 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value.

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN according to law, and the requisite action of the Board of Trustees of School District No. 414, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho (the "District"), that a School Plant Facilities Reserve Fund Levy election will be held on Tuesday, May 19, 2026, in the District for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said District their vote and determination, by affirmative vote of fifty-five percent (55%) of the electors voting in such election, at precinct polling sites open 8:00 a.m. through 8:00 p.m. on the following question:

QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 414, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho (the "District") be authorized and empowered, upon the affirmative vote of fifty-five percent (55%) of the electors of the District voting in the election, to levy a School Plant Facilities Reserve Fund Levy in the amount of up to Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2026, and continuing each year in the amount of up to Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for ten (10) years through fiscal year ending June 30, 2036, for the purposes permitted by law for school plant facilities levies?

Said election will be conducted pursuant to Title 34, Idaho Code.

Section 7. The Board of County Commissioners of Twin Falls County, Idaho, shall canvass the Plant Facilities Levy Election results in the manner prescribed by Idaho Code 34-1201, et seq. The County Clerk shall certify the Plant Facilities Levy Election results to the Clerk of the Board of Trustees of the District.

Section 8. That if at the election fifty-five percent (55%) of the qualified registered electors of the District authorize the plant facilities levy, the authorized levy shall be

approved and become effective in accordance with the provisions of § 33-804, Idaho Code.
