

**SCHOOL SUPPLEMENTAL MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS  
LEVY ELECTION RESOLUTION**

A RESOLUTION CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF MARSH VALLEY JT. SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 21, BANNOCK AND CARIBOU COUNTIES, IDAHO, THE PROPOSITION OF AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS LEVY.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Idaho Code §33-802(3), as amended, the Board of Trustees of Marsh Valley School District No. 21, Bannock County, Idaho (the "District"), has determined that there is a need for a supplemental levy in the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) each year for two years for the purpose of paying all lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the District for fiscal years beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2028 (the "Supplemental Levy") and, in order to do so, desires to provide for the holding of a special election as required by and in accordance with chapter 8 of Title 33 and chapters 1 and 14 of Title 34, Idaho Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Marsh Valley Jt. School District No. 21 as follows:

Section 1: That a special Supplemental Levy election be held, and the same is hereby called to be held in Marsh Valley Jt. School District No. 21 on Tuesday, May 19, 2026 (the "Levy Election"), for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the District, the question set out in the form of the ballot appearing in Section 5 hereof.

Section 2: That pursuant to Idaho Code §34-1401, the Clerks of Bannock and Caribou Counties, Idaho (the "County Clerk") shall administer the Levy Election, pursuant to and in accordance with Title 34, Idaho Code.

Section 3: That in compliance with Idaho Code §34-914, the clerk of the District shall notify the County Clerk that the District has called a Levy Election by delivering to the County Clerk a copy of this resolution, including the form of the official ballot appearing in Section 5 and the form of the notice of the Levy Election set forth in Section 6, for election preparation and publication pursuant to Title 34, Idaho Code. The clerk shall submit these forms to the County Clerk prior to March 13, 2026.

Section 4: That said Levy Election shall be conducted as other school elections by the County Clerk in accordance with Title 34, Idaho Code.

Section 5: That the form of the official ballot will be substantially as follows:

**QUESTION:** Shall the Board of Trustees of Marsh Valley Jt. School District #21, Bannock and Caribou Counties, Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) per year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026 and ending on June 30, 2028, for the purpose of financing any lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the District; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on March 11, 2026.

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed Supplemental Levy is a tax of \$42.10 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. If the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is expected to increase by \$42.10 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value.

**IN FAVOR** of authorizing a supplemental levy in the amount of \$1,000,000 per year for two years.

**NOTICE OF SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL LEVY ELECTION**

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and the Resolution of the Board of Trustees of Marsh Valley Jt. School District No. 21, Bannock and Caribou Counties, State of Idaho, adopted on March 11, 2026, a Supplemental Levy Election will be held on May 19, 2026, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. for the purpose of voting upon the question and proposition of authorizing a supplemental levy as follows:

QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of Marsh Valley Jt. School District No. 21, Bannock and Caribou Counties, State of Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) per year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026 and ending on June 30, 2028, for the purpose of financing any lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the District; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on March 11, 2026.

The purposes for which the proposed levy revenues will be used and the approximate amount of levy funds to be allocated for each use are as follows:

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$42.10 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. If the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is expected to increase by \$42.10.

Said Supplemental Levy Election will be conducted pursuant to Title 34, Idaho Code.

Section 7: That the County Commissioners will act as the canvassing board pursuant to Idaho Code §34-1410 and §§34-1201 *et seq.*, and the County Clerk will certify and convey the results to the District.

Section 8: That if at the Levy Election a simple majority of the qualified registered electors of the District authorize such levy, the Supplemental Levy shall be approved and become effective in accordance with the provisions of Idaho Code §33-802.
