Mr. DeLuna,

Following the Commission's June 11, 2026 action extending the deadline for Brabeion Academy's remaining pre-opening conditions to June 19, 2026, IPCSC staff has reviewed the additional documentation submitted by the school. This review focused on the two outstanding conditions related to the execution of Year 1 budget contracts and the securing of transportation services. Based upon the materials received, staff has assessed the status of each condition and provides the following analysis.

Condition 4: Charter holder provides the IPCSC evidence that all grants and contracts that are part of the Year 1 budget are signed or otherwise delivered by June 19, 2026.

Status: Met

Since the June 11, 2026 meeting, Brabeion Academy has submitted additional executed agreements and contracts that address the primary concerns previously identified regarding the school's readiness to operate.

The school submitted an executed technology services agreement with Benconnected for ongoing information technology management and support. The agreement includes network management and monitoring, cybersecurity protections, device management, Microsoft Intune licensing, content filtering, backup services, and technical support, with signatures from both parties dated June 11, 2026.

In addition, the school submitted an executed network infrastructure installation agreement with Benconnected for the installation and configuration of the school's network backbone, wireless access points, firewall, content filtering, and device deployment. The proposal was accepted and signed by Brabeion Academy on June 11, 2026.

The school also submitted executed agreements with Pye-Barker for installation of the school's door access and security system and for installation of the campus camera and surveillance system. Both proposals were signed by Brabeion Academy and the vendor on June 11, 2026 and provide evidence that critical safety and security infrastructure is being procured prior to opening.

Based on the contracts submitted, staff finds that Brabeion Academy has provided evidence that the previously identified technology and operational contracts included in the Year 1 budget have been secured. Accordingly, Condition 4 is considered met.

Condition 5: Charter holder provides the IPCSC evidence that sufficient transportation has been secured by June 19, 2026, to the extent holder intends to provide transportation.

Status: Met

Brabeion Academy has submitted multiple pieces of evidence demonstrating that transportation has been secured for the 2026-2027 school year.

First, Brown Bus Company provided a letter dated June 12, 2026 confirming its willingness and intent to provide student transportation services to Brabeion Academy and stating that it has submitted a bid proposal and is prepared to provide transportation if selected by the school's board.

More significantly, the school subsequently submitted a fully executed Vehicle Leasing Agreement between Brabeion Academy and Brown Bus Company dated June 12, 2026. The agreement provides for the lease of a school bus for the period of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027 and expressly states that the leased vehicle is to be used for the transportation of passengers.

While the agreement requires the school to provide licensed drivers, insurance, and operational oversight, it demonstrates that transportation equipment has been secured and that the school has taken substantial steps toward implementing its transportation plan. The school has also indicated that they have a staff member with a CDL that has agreed to serve in this role.

Based on the transportation commitment letter and the executed vehicle leasing agreement, staff finds that Brabeion Academy has provided sufficient evidence that transportation has been secured to the extent the school intends to provide transportation during Year 1. Accordingly, Condition 5 is considered met.

Conclusion

Based on the documentation submitted as of June 12, 2026, staff finds that Brabeion Academy has satisfied both remaining pre-opening conditions. The school has provided executed contracts supporting critical operational functions included in the Year 1 budget and has provided sufficient evidence that transportation has been secured for the 2026-2027 school year. Therefore, all pre-opening conditions imposed by the Commission appear to have been met prior to the June 19, 2026 deadline that was set during the June 11, 2026 Commission meeting.
