Dear Mr. Fletcher,

Coeur d'Alene Public Schools is requesting an extension of the current response deadline of September 10, 2026, to allow the District additional time to gather and review the necessary information related to this matter and to consult with legal counsel. We have every intention of protecting our covered employees, their dependents, and eligible retirees.

Given the nature and significance of the information involved, we want to ensure that the District has an opportunity to fully understand the circumstances and implications before providing a formal response. Accordingly, we respectfully request an extension of the September 10, 2026 response deadline. We anticipate being able to provide a response following our Board meeting on September 14, 2026. According to a phone conversation with Director Dean Cameron on September 2, 2026, an extension would be allowable under certain circumstances.

As stewards of taxpayer funds, we require additional information in order to pay an amount of this magnitude. To date, we have not received an official invoice, including the total number of ISBT beneficiaries, as well as our number of covered employees, their dependents, and eligible retirees upon which the total of \$1,864,248.48 was arrived at; only an email communication from Debbie Hainke, ISBT Benefits Manager, on August 27, 2026. This was received after email communication on August 20, 2026, also from Ms. Hainke, and communication from Acrisure, our insurance broker, on August 4, 2026, each of which had differing amounts owed. Please remit an official invoice as soon as possible with this information. In addition, we are requesting a copy of the Petition for Rehabilitation Order filed by the Department of Insurance in case number CV01-26-17631. Please provide this petition by Monday, September 14th at 5 pm MT.

We appreciate your understanding and consideration of this request.
