Gym and Locker Room Renovation: Replacing the gym floor, removing the cloud to improve lighting and energy efficiency with an added drop down ceiling, new bleachers that are reconfigured for better spectator access, adding score boards to each end of the gym, and updating the boys' and girls' locker rooms with renovated restrooms, private shower stalls, and more accessible concessions.	\$1,500,000

Purpose	Approximate Amount Allocated	
Gym and Locker Room Renovation: Replacing the gym floor, removing the cloud to improve lighting and energy efficiency with an added drop down ceiling, new bleachers that are reconfigured for better spectator access, adding score boards to each end of the gym, and updating the boys' and girls' locker rooms with renovated restrooms, private shower stalls, and more accessible concessions.	\$400,000	
Replacing Aging Stadium Lighting: PHS' football and baseball facilities are in need of new lights and light poles to improve light quality, safety, and reliability.	\$600,000	
Adding Secure Entrance Vestibule at Payette Primary School: This practical improvement reflects today's school safety standards and will improve visitor screening and overall campus security at PPS.	\$200,000	
Replace Outdated Playground Equipment: PPS' playground equipment is 35 years old and showing its age and wear. This will replace all the playground equipment, on both sides of the Primary School playground.	\$200,000	
Reconditioning of Sports Fields: The football field at MMS and the PHS soccer field at the track need to be reconditioned. The reconditioned fields will provide a better environment for physical education classes, middle and high school athletics, and community use, ensuring our students have safe, functional fields to practice and compete.	\$ 100,000

QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of Payette Joint School District NO. 371, Payette and Washington Counties, State of Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) per year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2027 and ending June 30, 2029, for the purposes stated above; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on August 19, 2026?		
The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$121 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions.
