SCHOOL PLANT FACILITIES RESERVE FUND LEVY ELECTION

WEISER SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 431, WASHINGTON COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO

November 3, 2026

QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of Weiser School District No. 431, Washington County, State of Idaho (the "District") be authorized and empowered, upon the affirmative vote of fifty-five percent (55%) of the electors of the District voting in the election, to levy a School Plant Facilities Reserve Fund Levy in the amount of up to Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000) for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2027, and continuing each year in the amount of up to Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000) for four (4) years through fiscal year ending June 30, 2031, for the purposes permitted by law for school plant facilities levies?

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$35 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy replaces an existing levy that expires on June 30, 2027 and that currently costs \$31 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value. Therefore, if the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, is expected to increase by \$4 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value.
